| Favourite | Favorite | |
| Centre | Center | The middle point or part of something. |
| Theatre | Theater | A place where plays, films, or performances are shown. |
| Metre | Meter | |
| Defence | Defense | The act of protecting from harm or danger. |
| Licence | License | Permission or freedom to act; also a legal document granting permission. |
| Aluminium | Aluminum | |
| Traveller | Traveler | A person who journeys to a different place. |
| Enrolment | Enrollment | The act of signing up or registering for something. |
| Dialogue | Dialog | |
| Programme | Program | A planned series of events, activities, or software applications. |
| Neighbour | Neighbor | |
| Ageing | Aging | The process of becoming older or more mature. |
